► Academics & Programs

Students are challenged through AP, Honors, Dual Enrollment, STEM with PLTW, and a robust college prep program designed to spark their full potential.

With dedicated learning support, study skills classes, and accessible advanced coursework, every student is equipped to thrive and succeed.



CLASS OF 2026

COLLEGE & CAREER

- 62 graduates are heading directly to a two- or four-year college or university.
- 11 graduates will be attending trade school or entering the workforce.

ACADEMIC ACHIEVEMENTS

- Class of 2026 earned \$10.1 million in college scholarship offers.
- On average, 80% of Advanced Placement students earn passing scores on their AP exams.
- 57% of graduates completed at least one college-level Advanced Placement (AP) course.
- Of those AP students, 46% completed five or more AP courses.
- 67% of graduates took at least one Project Lead the Way (PLTW) Biomedical Science or Engineering course.

ARTS & RECOGNITIONS

- One student was selected to perform with the Illinois All-State Choir.
- Ten students earned the Illinois State Seal of Biliteracy, recognizing intermediate-high proficiency in English and at least one additional language.
- Thirteen students received the Illinois State Scholar Award, an honor awarded to approximately 10% of graduating seniors across Illinois.
- One senior was recognized as a National Merit Scholarship Program Commended Student, a distinction honoring exceptional academic achievement and PSAT performance.
